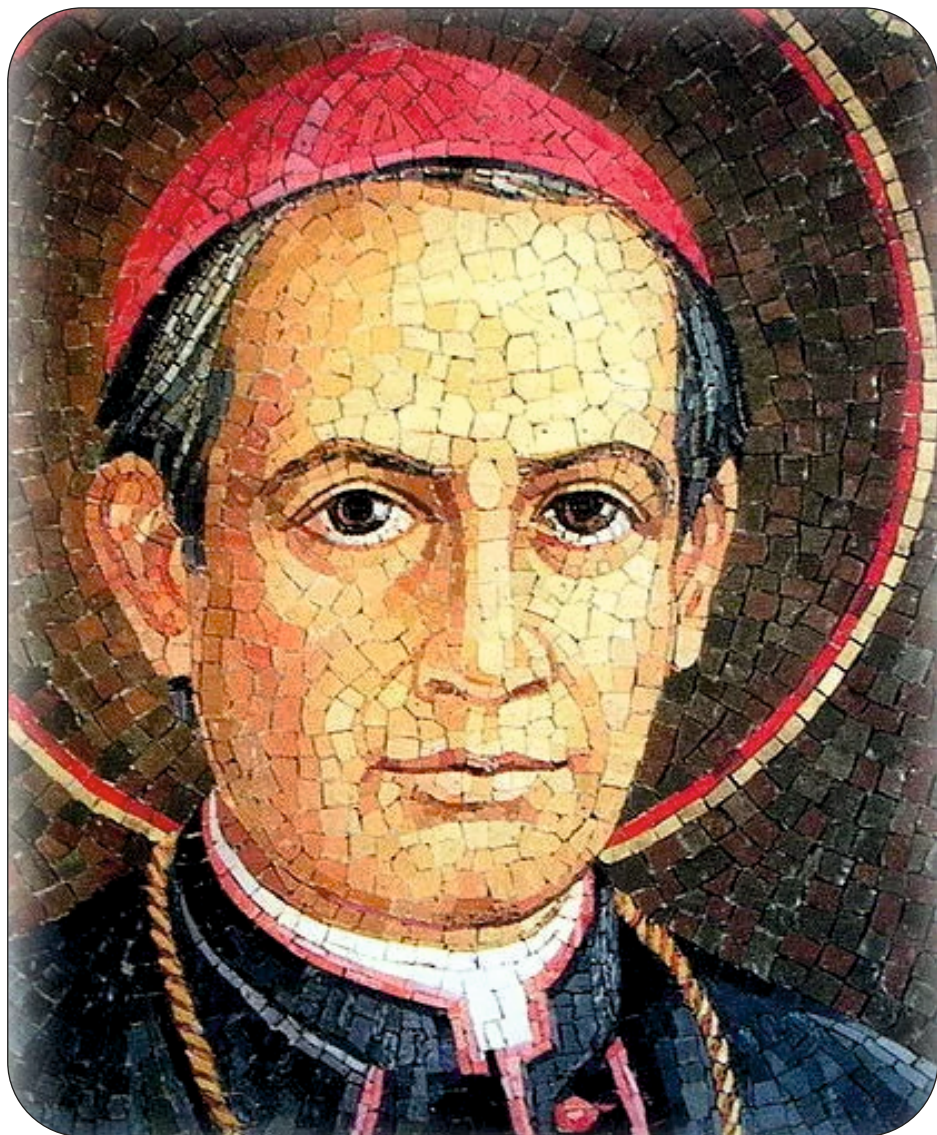

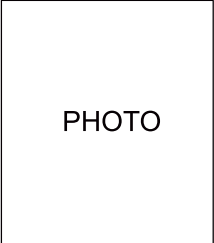

The creative curriculum and specialized methods of teaching contribute to the children's Cognitive and emotional development, Communication (LSRW Skills), Knowledge and understanding of the world, Creative and aesthetic development, Physical development, Mathematical awareness and development.

8.2 Pre-Primary: Nurturing the young minds : U.K.G.

Teaching method at this level is very interactive which initiates life-long learning. Integrated learning takes place in and out of the classroom through problem solving, reading, language, mathematics, etc. Children plan their activities, take responsibilities for learning. There is a high scope for learning while children discuss what they did and how they liked doing it and what they learnt from it. They are helped to differentiate between positive and negative behaviors. Children are rewarded for their good choices which boost their confidence.

8.3. Primary : Igniting the Child's Potential : Grades - I - II

Students are emphasized on reading, writing and arithmetic skills. Exploration and discovery is the method of teaching to help students learn conceptually. Students are given ample opportunity to work together, discuss possible solutions, and speculate about theories. They are encouraged to look at many possible ways to solve a problem, rather than one solution. They make observations, ask questions and share their ideas. The outcome is more learning, new ideas and curiosity satisfaction.

8.4. Primary : Fostering the youngest learners : Grades - III - V

Children learn about the values of learning at this age of self-discovery. Variety of teaching methods in classrooms are used to address the differing needs of students. The students work alone, with partners, and in small and large groups. However, they learn to explore the facts, how things work and why it happens, and they develop the ability to think “if” and “then” questions. They are given opportunities to understand in a broader dimension to apply their knowledge to solve problems.

8.5. Middle School : Creating Confident Learners : Grades - VI - VIII

At the middle level, a stimulating curriculum, guidance and support in all aspects, combine to develop a sense of confidence and independence that equip our students for life. It encourages an integrated approach to teaching-learning, so as to enable children to comprehend learning experiences as a unified whole, to help them see meaningful linkages within and across various subject areas. It is centralized to children's intellectual, social, emotional growth and all-round development.

8.6. High School : Fostering Life-Long Learners: Grades - IX - X

At this level, the focus is on the individual where both excellence and progress are celebrated. High School teaching is built upon the academic foundations that were developed in the subjects taught during the middle school years. The instructional program is amplified through practical opportunities for the development of leadership, service and academic enrichment through student organizations, sports teams and project works. The project work supports and extends the innate curiosity of the child and develops the attitudes and skills necessary to gain an understanding of the world around.

By the end of their time at school, students will have achieved outstanding personal success and have developed a genuine love of learning. They will continue their pursuit of education and excellence and will, above all else, leave the institution with confidence and be prepared to play a vital role in the society.

18. Admissions and withdrawals :

- 26.7** Refrain from planning outings during school working days / exam days. If any dire need of leave arise, inform the Principal with a formal letter.
- 26.8** Avoid public negative remarks on the school. If you have a genuine issue, approach the school office.
- 26.9** Take prior appointment to meet the teacher. Visiting time (3.00p.m - 3.30p.m). Teachers will not be available after the said timings.
- 26.10** Parents will be informed of any injuries to the children during school hours and necessary care will be taken.
- 26.11** Check the **ENTAB** app on a daily basis and ensure that the child does the necessary work given by the teachers.
- 26.12** Kindly send home made food with the children and avoid junk food that can harm them.
- 26.13** If the child is absent, it should be brought to the notice of the teacher, but if the leave prolongs for more than a week, kindly inform the office. This will help us to attend such children personally.
